1. The Visual Arts Tent showcases the original works of local/regional artists selected by the Summer in the City committee. Only original arts pieces will be permitted as approved by the Summer in the City Festival. Failure to adhere to these restrictions will result in a rejected application and possible removal from the tent. Any questions or concerns regarding vendor items should be brought to the attention of the festival coordinator (see contact info below). Limited numbers accepted due to space restrictions. Priority given to local and then regional artists.
2. The Summer in the City Festival reserves the right to accept or reject all applications received and to designate the location of spaces.
3. Subletting of booth space is strictly prohibited. You must have your area attended at all times. Insurance is artists' responsibility.
4. Booths must be open during the entire duration of the **Visual Arts Tent Hours: June 15<sup>th</sup>: 12:00pm – 9:00pm & June 16: 12:00pm – 9:00pm.**
5. The Goal is to have much arts and cultural activity down the Main Street, and artists working alongside their display/demonstrating for the public. Preference will be given to artists who participate and add to the creative diversity, and to local and regional artists.
